Tax free

Lump sum death benefits from a pension scheme can be paid at the discretion of the Trustees direct to your beneficiaries without any inheritance tax liability. Your beneficiaries are defined in the Scheme Rules and include your relatives and dependants.

Your wishes

You should tell the Trustees who you wish to be treated as your beneficiary(ies) by filling in the Expression of Wish form overleaf.

The Trustees will give every consideration to your wishes before paying the lump sum but your nomination is not legally binding.

You can change your nomination whenever you want. You should always keep your expression of Wish form up to date.

There is no restriction on the number of beneficiaries you can nominate. You are free to nominate an organisation to receive the benefit if you wish. This is also not legally binding.

Confidential

Your nomination will be treated as confidential in any event but you may want to place your completed form in a sealed envelope not to be opened unless you die. If so, you should mark the envelope in that way.

Planning your inheritance tax

Inheritance tax is chargeable on the value of a person's estate.

Transfers of value between spouses are completely free of inheritance tax, as are inheritance transfers up to a fixed levels and certain transfers to charities.

Your nominations should be discussed with your legal adviser while reviewing or preparing the terms of your will.

Witness

The Trustees require your signature to be verified by an individual who is NOT a beneficiary noted on this form. This is to verify, not your wishes, but the fact that the person who has signed and completed this form is the same.
